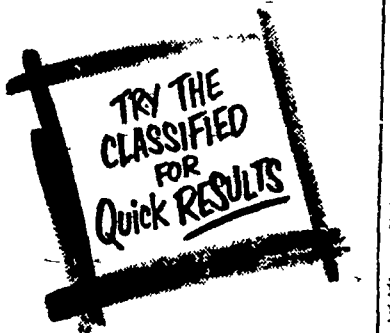

Scholarship to Be Awarded by Angus Auxiliary

Applications are now being taken for qualified 4-H or farm youth group girls who qualify for the \$300 college scholarship awarded by the National Women's Auxiliary of the American Angus Assn, announces Mrs. J. C. Holbert, chairman of the scholarship committee.

The award is made annually on the basis of merit and need. Among qualifications listed by the Auxiliary for eligibility to receive the scholarship are: (1) The applicant shall have manifested an interest in Angus projects and be actively engaged in such projects at the time of application; (2) She shall be a graduating high school senior who needs financial assistance to further her education; (3) She shall be recommended by either county agent, 4-H or other club advisor and either her school principal or superintendent; and (4) Each state or regional auxiliary is entitled to have one applicant.
