

## Champion COT Birds Bring \$6.50 To Equal Record Set at Coatesville

The Pennsylvania state champion junior chicken grower pocketed a check for \$347.75 when his 1958 Chicken of Tomorrow entry of 15 broiler-fryer chickens brought \$6.50 per pound at auction May 7 in Sunbury. The price per pound equaled the all-time state record set at Coatesville in 1955.

The happy boy is 16-year-old Fred R. Romig of Beaver Springs RD 1, Snyder County. The check came from Mattern's hatchery, Beaver Springs, where Fred bought his chicks. It was the highest bid at all six regional auctions where more than 600 entries were sold today.

Young Romig's cross-bred chickens won the state title at the Farm Show Building on Tuesday in competition with the 24 top entries out of the original 43 in the statewide contest. The 15 dressed chickens weighed 53½ pounds, averaging 3½ pounds each at 9½ weeks of age.

Second best price in the State was \$3.00 per pound paid at the Fredericksburg auction for the reserve championship entry of Loren L. Worman, 19, Bernville RD, Berks County. His lot weighed 59 pounds and netted him \$174 from Purina Mills, the buyer. While the reserve champion birds weighed more than the champion entry, the judges found slightly higher quality gave the edge to the Romig chickens.

State champion birds brought \$6 per pound in 1956 and 1957. At each auction the regional grand champion brought the highest price per pound, as follows: (Continued on page thirteen)

1955. Statewide, the average price was 54.77 cents a pound. Live contest birds sold for an average of 24.11 cents a pound at the Lancaster Poultry Exchange Thursday.
