### Colored Poultry Litter Being Tested

Since different colors absorb heat in varying degrees, researchers at Colorado State University are running an experiment to see if chicks thrive better on one color of litter than another. In the tests, wood shavings dyed red, green, blue, orange, black, and

undyed shavings are being used.

The main purpose of the study, according to Chief Poultryman Robert Moreng of Colorado State, is to determine the effect of litter temperature on growth of chicks, but the degree of activity in chicks on the different colors of litter will also be observed. Perhaps, Dr Moreng says, one color will cause the chicks to be nervous and jumpy, while another color may be more soothing.

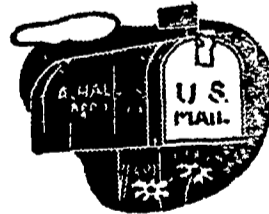
