Cat, Dog Food Sales Stopped By Foods Bureau

Orders to stop sale on three brands of canned dog food and one of cat food were issued today by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture against stores in Northwestern Pennsylvania

According to Delmar K' Myers, Acting Director, Bureau of Foods and Chemistry, the four brands of pet foods were found to be deficient in fat content when tested at the Department Laboratory in Harrisburg

The presence of only one fifth of the amount of fat guaranteed by the manufacturer represents serious misbranding", Myers said "Purchasers are entitled to receive the full amount of nutritional materials which the label guarantees to be present"

During 1957 nearly 3,200 samples of animal feed were test ed by the Bureau of Foods and Chemistry. The large majority were poultry feeds, dairy rations, steer supplements, and similar feeds used by Pennsylvania farmers in the production of meat, milk and eggs, Myers reported
