Broiler Market Generally Steady With a Good Demand at Week's Start

PHILADELPHIA, June 16 — A generally steady market with good demand typified the broiler market at the beginning of this week
Last week the broiler-feed ratio moved down a point to 43 with the price of feed and broilers both dropping However compared with the ratio six months ago, it is considerably better as far as the producer is concerned In December the price of broil-

ers averaged 15 6 cents a pound in the Delmarva area and feed was \$94 74 a ton Last week the broiler average was 21 62 cents a pound and the feed price was quoted at \$100 96 a ton
Here is how the market looked on Tuesday in the major meat bird producing areas.

DELMARVA Market steady Offerings heavy Demand good Prices paid at the farm were from 21½ to 22¼ cents with half the sales undetermined Some 220,000 head were moved Most sales were at 21½ cents

GEORGIA Offerings generally in balance with needs although continue barely adequate at a few points Demand good The prevailing price was 20 cents for 774,000 head

NORTH CAROLINA Offerings adequate Demand good Twenty cents was the price paid for all of 565,700 head sold
SHENANDOAH VALLEY Demand fair Offerings ample Undertone unsettled Prices were from 20 to 21 4 cents a pound for 145,000 head Twentythree per cent of the sales were at 20 cents, 34 per cent at 21 eight per cent at 21 4 cents and 35 per cent undetermined
ARKANSAS Demand good at most points, fair at some Offerings adequate at most points Undergrades being discounted from one to three cents Of 552,430 head sold 60 per cent of the sales were at 21 cents 32 per cent undetermined, intra company sales moved three per cent of the volume at 20 cents and five per cent at 21 cents
