¼ cup sliced pimiento-stuffed olives  
 3 stalks celery  
 1 medium-sized green pepper  
 ½ cup mayonnaise or salad dressing  
 12 slices enriched sandwich bread, toasted  
 Butter or margarine  
 Lettuce leaves  
 Mayonnaise or salad dressing  
 Minced parsley  
 Combine ham, cheese dill pickle and olives. Cut celery and green pepper into julienne strips and add to ham mixture. Add the one-half cup mayonnaise or salad dressing and toss lightly. Spread toast with butter or margarine. Trim crusts, if desired. Cut six slices diagonally into halves. Arrange one whole toast slice with two halves on opposite sides for each sandwich. Place lettuce over toast. Measure about three-fourth cup of ham mixture onto lettuce on center piece of toast. Top with

small amount of mayonnaise or salad dressing and sprinkle with parsley. To garnish, place tomato slice and radish roses on the other toast triangle. Makes 6 sandwiches.

## BILTMORE

12 slices whole wheat or rye bread (trim crusts, if desired)  
 12 slices Swiss cheese (6 ounces)  
 6 slices baked ham  
 Melted butter or margarine  
 Place a slice of Swiss cheese on each bread slice. Arrange ham slice on top of six slices. Put slices together to close sandwich. Brush the outside of each sandwich with melted butter or margarine. Put into waffle baker and bake until golden brown. For serving cut each sandwich into halves. Serve with dill pickles. Makes 6 sandwiches.

## CELEBRITY HAM SANDWICH

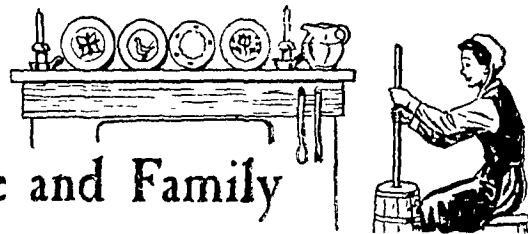
8 ounces cream cheese, softened  
 ¼ cup prepared horseradish  
 1½ teaspoon paprika  
 12 slices rye bread  
 12 slices baked ham (12 ounces)  
 Drained green asparagus

spears  
 Blend cream cheese, horseradish and paprika. Spread a layer of cheese mixture over all bread slices. Arrange ham slices over cheese on all bread slices. Place three or four asparagus spears on half the slices. Cover with remaining slices to close sandwiches. Secure with wooden picks. Cut diagonally into halves. Garnish with carrot and celery sticks and dill pickle. Makes 6 sandwiches.

## WEST COAST SPECIAL

12 slices enriched sandwich bread, toasted  
 Butter or margarine  
 1 pound flaked crab meat  
 2 cups shredded lettuce (about)  
 Special Dressing  
 6 crisp bacon slices  
 Spread toast with butter or margarine. Trim crusts, if desired. Cut 6 slices diagonally into halves. Arrange one whole slice and two halves on opposite sides for each sandwich. Place lettuce over toast and arrange crab meat over lettuce. Spoon about one-half cup Special Dressing over each

sandwich and top with a slice of crisp bacon. Garnish with tomato, hard cooked egg, olives and parsley. Makes 6 sandwiches.

## SPECIAL DRESSING

2 cups mayonnaise or salad dressing  
 1 cup undiluted evaporated milk  
 ¼ cup vinegar  
 ¼ cup sugar  
 ½ cup chili sauce  
 ½ cup India relish  
 ¼ cup finely chopped green onion  
 ¼ cup finely chopped celery  
 ¼ cup finely chopped green pepper

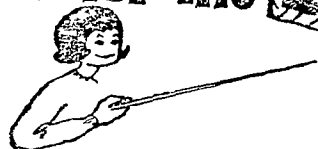
2 table-poons minced pimiento  
 2 tea-poons salt  
 ½ tea-poon garlic salt  
 ½ tea-poon onion salt  
 2 hard cooked eggs, chopped  
 Mix all ingredients and chill. Makes about five cups dressing.

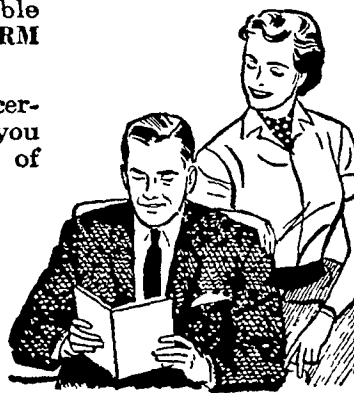
