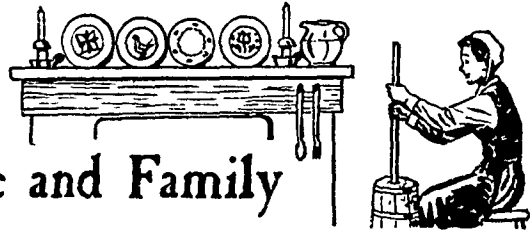

Leave enough headspace for expansion in freezing. Apply the lid or the container for a tight seal and freeze promptly.

Try this Dessert Shortcake with the above topping —

DESSERT SHORTCAKE

2 cups sifted all-purpose flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1 teaspoon salt

2 tablespoons sugar
1/2 cup lard
6 tablespoons milk
1 egg, well beaten

Melted butter or margarine
Sift flour, baking powder, salt and sugar. Cut in shortening with pastry blender or two knives until mixture resembles coarse meal. Blend milk and egg and add to dry ingredients, mix until well blended. Turn dough out on lightly floured board and knead gently for a few seconds. Roll dough to 1/4 inch thickness, cut in 12-3-inch rounds. Brush lightly with melted butter. Place in pairs, buttered sides together, on ungreased baking sheet and bake at 425 degrees for 12 to 15 minutes. Remove top halves and spoon prepared fruit between and on top of shortcake rounds. 6 servings.

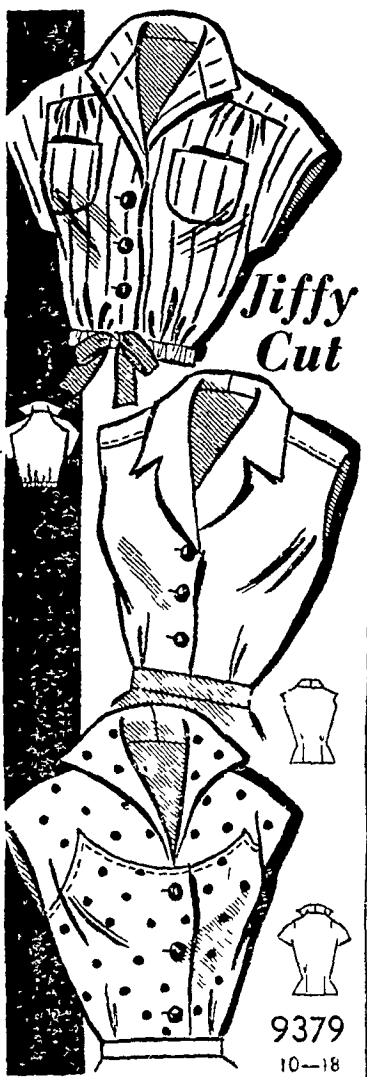
When cooking with cheese, use low temperature, high temperature and long cooking make cheese tough and stringy.

Local Milk Prices To Rise October 1

Lancaster area milk prices will increase one cent per quart as of October 1, according to a release by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Marketing Service. Philadelphia and suburban areas will not be affected by this seasonal rise.

This seasonal pricing plan is incorporated to offset additional costs to farmers for barn feeding livestock when pastures dry up in the fall.

Letter to the Editor

Editor, Lancaster Farming

This is in answer to a request on ways to use saffron in cooking. Saffron is the dried stigma or pistil of a type of crocus that blooms in the fall of the year. It has a deep orange hue, and a small amount will color and flavor a variety of foods.

Saffron may be added during the last twenty minutes of cooking time to any soup that has a meat or chicken broth base. It may also be added to the broth used in making all types of pot pies, as well as in dressing for poultry and other meats.

For a lift at mealtime, try potatoes with saffron dressing.

Pare, slice, and wash the quantity of potatoes desired. Place one-half of the sliced potatoes in a kettle, sprinkling with flour and some butter cut in small pieces. Add the balance of potatoes, sprinkle again with flour and butter, and add a small amount of saffron and salt. Add COLD water, barely enough to cover. Cook over medium heat until potatoes are done.

NOTE: In order to obtain proper consistency for saffron dressing, use one heaping teaspoonful to flour to one cup of COLD water
