**Supply Adequate; Trading Light In Major Broiler Producing Areas**

The broiler market continued steady in most of the major producing areas this week. The Delmarva market was quiet with trading light and a considerable portion at undertermined prices.

The Delmarva broiler feed ration was lower at 3.4, with broilers averaging 16.39 cents and feed selling for \$97.50 a ton. Last week the ratio stood at 3.5 when broilers brought 17.15 cents and feed was selling for \$98.14 a ton.

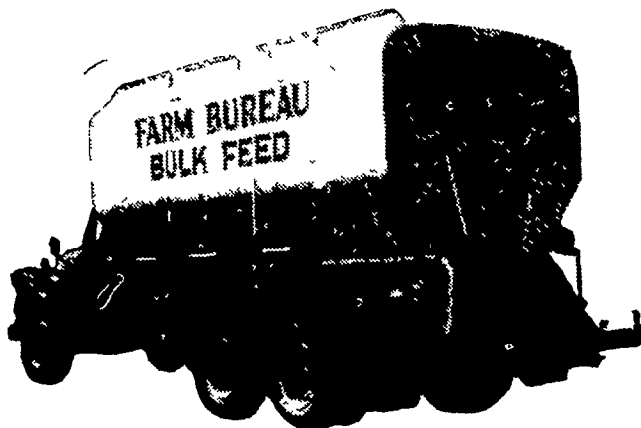

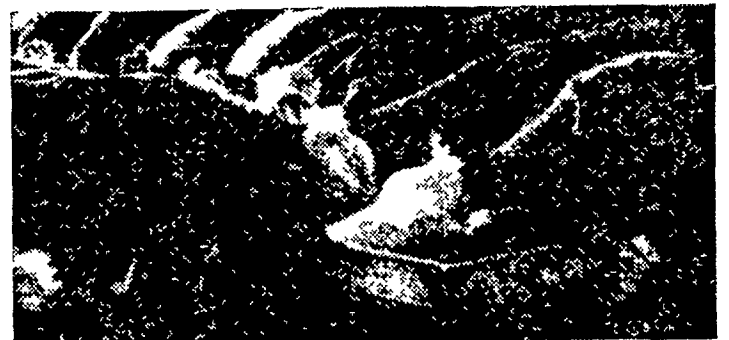
