



TRENCH SILOS HAVE DEVELOPED AS a common method of storing roughage on farms. Common for several years, the structures are receiving the latest "split-level" treatment on the John H. Stauffer farm, RD 1, Willow Street. Construction is underway on a 200-ton capacity, 50x20x10 concrete trench, which will have a five-foot rise, in the floor 30-feet from the front. After the lower-front portion is filled, silage wagons will be able to drive out the upper end, without climbing the usual steep ramp. The silo also is expected to feature a self-feeding gate, but if this device is unsatisfactory, it is only a few feet to the regular feeding shed, for Stauffer's 40-head Holstein herd, which averages 1,200 lbs. of milk daily, with a 1957 average per cow fat production of 452 lbs. 




