

## Scholastic Judging Contests Set For Eastern Nat'l Livestock Exposition

TIMONIUM, Md — College students and 4-H boys and girls will compete in a series of special judging contests to be held in conjunction with the twelfth annual Eastern National Livestock Show to be held at the Maryland State Fair Grounds here November 15 through 20.

Five man teams from agricultural colleges in the United States and Canada are eligible to compete in the Intercollegiate

Livestock Judging Contest scheduled for the opening day of the livestock exposition.

The college students will be asked to judge beef cattle, sheep and swine, and give the reasons for their selection, in a competition for \$300 in cash prizes. Last year, students from twelve colleges participated in the event.

In another contest, college teams are scheduled to compete in the Intercollegiate Meat Judging Contest in which they will be asked to grade eleven classes of meat.

Judging will include classes of beef carcasses, wholesale beef cuts, pork carcasses, wholesale pork cuts and lamb carcasses. Awards will include trophies, plaques, ribbons, tie clasps and certificates of participation.

The National Live Stock and Meat Board Trophy will be awarded to the team making the highest score and a special plaque will be awarded to the high team by the management of the Eastern National.

This event will be held November 18 at the Esskay Packing Plant in Baltimore.

State teams of 4-H boys and girls are eligible to compete in the Interstate 4-H Cub Meat and November 15. The contestants will judge eight classes of four animals each, including three classes of fat barrows, one class of breeding cattle, two classes of fat steers, one class of breeding sheep and one class of fat lambs.

The contestants will be required to give oral reasons for their placings.

Ribbons and trophies will be awarded at a dinner to be given by the management of the Eastern National on November 16.
