

July-August Farm Exports Near Total 1.5-million Metric Tons Shipped

The U S Department of Agriculture reports that during the months of July and August 1958 agricultural exports under Title I of Public Law 480 amounted to 1,496,000 metric tons.

Shipments during August 1958 totaled 919,000 metric tons based on copies of shipping documents received by the Department from exporters. The commodity breakdown of shipments follows:

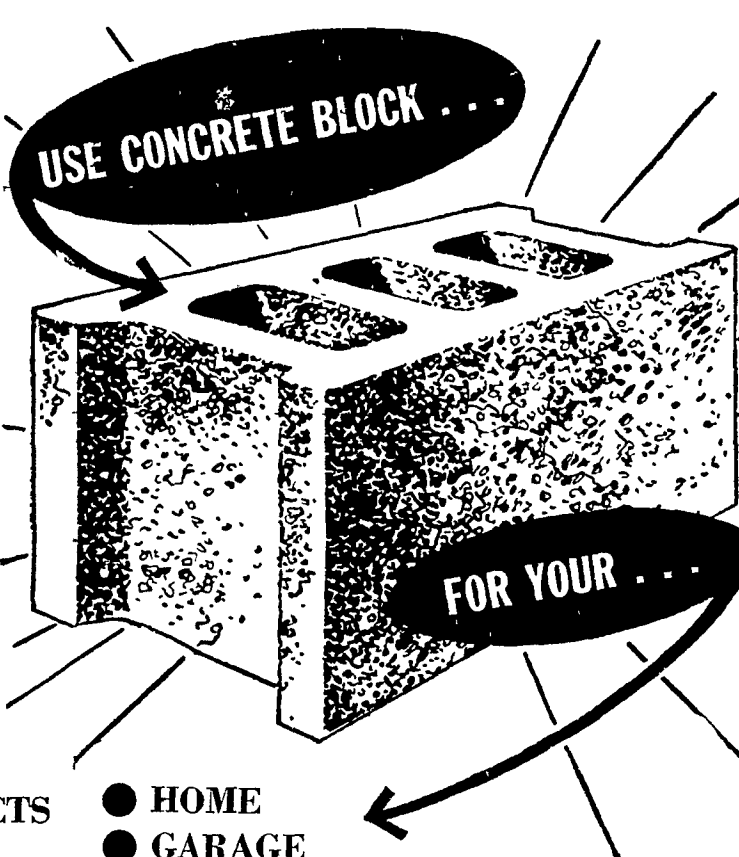

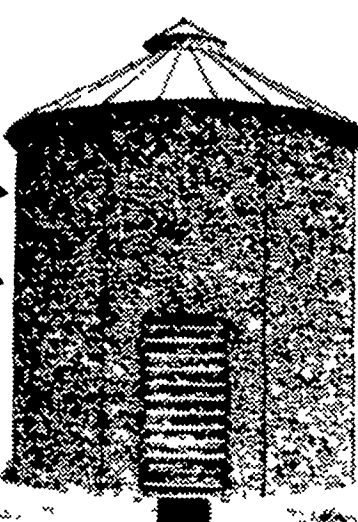
