Seven lots with 6,075 capettes brought a price range of 18 to 245, and one lot of 170 Leghorn fowls brought 105



This included 20 lots of broilers, with 69250 birds, averaging 189

Despite the early season falling off in broiler prices this year, Lancaster Poultry Exchange over the rst eight months of 1958 maintained nearly a onecent-per-pound higher average than prices in the DELMARVA 1 eg10n.

The 35 week period of January to September, 1958 shows local prices averaged 21.44 cents per pound paid for broilers, against DELMARVA's 2053 average (The complete breakdown, by weeks, may be found elsewhere in this paper)


