

Eastern Broiler Markets Improve With Delmarva Broiler-Feed Ratio Up

Delmarva broiler market recovered somewhat from the previous week's low as the market steadied, with heavy 471/2-481/2 offerings and good demand. Larger sizes were in the upper part of the range.

Much of the improvement in the ratio was due to the price drop of feed in the area. Per ton prices of 20 per cent broiler mash tell off \$4.16, from \$98 90 to \$94.74, or 32 cents above the per ton price of a year ago




