Several Lancaster County and surrounding area Holsteins have recently completed official testing records with Penn State University, according to the Holstein-Friesian Association of America, Brattleboro, Vt.

Willow Grove Acme, a 14-year-old, milked twice daily for 365 days, owned by Paul H. Eby, Cochranville, produced a total of 13,795 lbs. of milk and 533 lbs. of butterfat.

Robelgov Gaiwood Nina, a 3-year-old, owned by Robert C. Groff, Quarryville, milked twice daily for 323 days, produced 13,759 lbs. of milk, and 568 lbs. of butterfat.

Wightwick Masterpiece Pride, a 7-year-old, milked twice daily for 357 days, and owned by Paul G. Longenecker, Strasburg produced a total of 12,173 lbs. of milk and 528 lbs. of BF.

John C. Metzler, Christiana, had two Holsteins completing official records. Mintdale Bessie Jean produced a total of 16,219 lbs. of milk and 575 lbs. of BF as a 12-year-old. Winding Glen Skokie

Oirpha produced 18,035 lbs. of milk and 736 lbs. of BF as a 7-year-old. Both were milked twice daily for 365 days.

Rose Rag Apple De Kol, a 7-year-old, owned by Harvey Retew, Manheim, produced a total of 18,919 lbs. of milk and 737 lbs. of BF, milking twice daily for 365 days.

Smyrna View Beau Dean Fobes, a 3-year-old, owned by Steven K. Stoltz, Christiana, recorded a total of 11,187 lbs. of milk and 409 lbs. of BF, milking twice daily for 307 days.

Brnk Vil Sue Design Palst, a 2-year-old, owned by Isaac M. Brubaker, Lititz, milking twice daily for 315 days produced 11,223 lbs. of milk and 450 lbs. of BF.

Red Rose Sovereign Peonavel, a 3-year-old, milked twice daily and owned by John W. Eshelman and Sons, Red Rose Research Center, Lancaster, produced 13,849 lbs. of milk and 600 lbs. of BF.

Winstead Lado Lucifer, a 7-year-old, owned by Robert C. Groff, Quarryville, milking twice daily for 365 days produced 14,614 lbs. of milk and 623 lbs. of BF.
