 instances 25¢ higher. Around 15 loads slaughter steers mostly over 1175 lbs and few loads stockers and feeders unsold, clearance complete other classes.

**STEERS.** Load 956 lb choice slaughter steers \$29.00, few lots and loads 1000-1220 lb, high good lot mainly choice \$26-27.50. Load 1240 lb choice \$25, 100 head averaging 1101 lbs included at \$27. Bulk 1000-1300 lb largely good to low-choice steers \$24-25.50, small lot 1084 lb, standards at \$22.75.

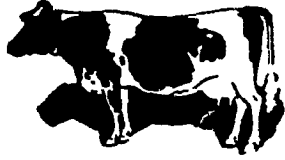

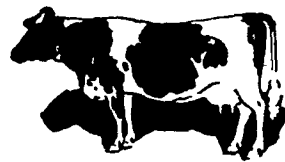
