

Price Average Drops to 16.4 At Lancaster Poultry Exch. Auction

LANCASTER Oct 9 — The Oct 9 broiler market at Lancaster Poultry Exchange continued the season's trend by dropping some more to a 16.40 average on 38 lots of 161,650 broilers sold. A total of 62 lots were offered with 189,450 birds, with 53 lots including 174,920 birds being sold. The listing included 13 lots of capettes which sold bringing from 18.1 to 21.3 on 11,270 birds. At last year's corresponding sale, 37 lots were offered with 79,740 birds. Thirty-one lots sold, with 74,890 birds. The average for 24 lots of broilers was 18.63. BALTIMORE, Oct 13 — CATTLE AND CALVES Supply comprised of approximately 50% slaughter steers, 28% stockers and feeders and 22% cows. Trading on slaughter steers under 1100 lbs moderately active, weights over 1100 lbs slow. Slaughter steers uneven. Standard and good steers over 1150 lbs. steady to 25¢ lower, other steers about steady with instances 25¢ higher early on choice steers under 1100 lbs.

Slaughter heifers nominally steady. Cows moderately active fully steady to strong. Bulls slow and steady. Vealers moderately active and fully steady. Slaughter calves steady to weak. Stockers and feeders slow, mostly steady.

CATTLE Supply includes about 20% slaughter steers and 70% stockers and feeders. Trading moderately active on all classes except feeder steers which were slow. Slaughter steers weighing under 1150 lb and grading choice or better steady, heavier weights and short fed steers weak to mostly 50¢ lower.

Cows steady to 25¢ lower. Bulls steady.

Stock steers steady, feeder steers 25-50¢ lower. Bulk choice 950-1180 lb slaughter steers \$26.50-28, including load 1325 lb \$25.90, several loads and lots choice and prime 993 1294 lb \$28.25-28.50, two loads same grade 1438-1447 lb \$27.50 small lot

prime 1063 lb \$29 good to low choice \$24.50-26.75, standard and low good \$22.24-50

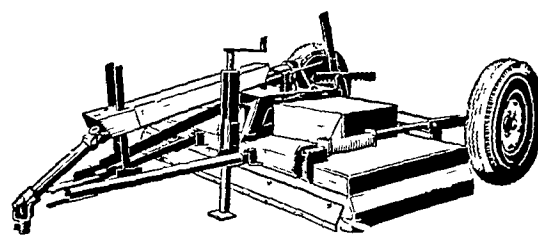
