Q How old must a young man or woman be before they can purchase a car without the signature of the parent?

A There is no law in Pennsyl vania which says that a person niust be a certain age before they can purchase an automobile with or without the signature of their parent It is the law in Pennsylvania, however, that a contract made by a minor, heing a person under 21 years, can be voided, or cancelled, by the minor at any time before he teaches 21 years of age, or within a reasonable time thereafter For this reason, any one who sells an automobile to a person under 21 years of age takes the risk of having such person de fault on the sale, and the seller to demand the automobile back heim RD 1, 18 acres


