### QUALITY CATTLE DICTATE PROFITS

The number of cows in the dairy herd is not always an indication of the profit-ability of the dairy enterprise: the production per cow is a much better measure of production efficiency. Robert A. Powers, Jr., Chester county agent reports a recent analysis of DHIA records shows that cows producing 300 pounds of butterfat per year return the owner only \$20 per year profit after expenses; but a 500 pound producer may return as much as \$132 profit for the year.

The number of cows needed to pay expenses other than feed cost is determined by the level of production. Mr. Powers says 33 cows producing 250 pounds of fat are needed to give \$5000 return

over feed cost, where only 13 cows producing 500 pounds of fat are needed to give the same returns.

Dairy herds are expanding in size but Mr. Powers warns that the number of cows should not be increased at the expense of production per cow, or there will be no net gain in income for the dairymen. Often the number of cows can be reduced, and with better feed and care the remaining cows will return more profit for the owner.
