banquet, and tours. This seventh annual State-wide meeting is open to all interested homemakers. Registration will start about the middle of May and all homemakers must register for the three days. Eight homemakers, two from each of the four districts, are on the planning committee. They include Mrs. Owen H. Groff, Oxford, Chester county.

Trademarks Are Good Buying Guides

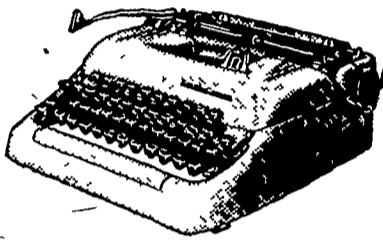

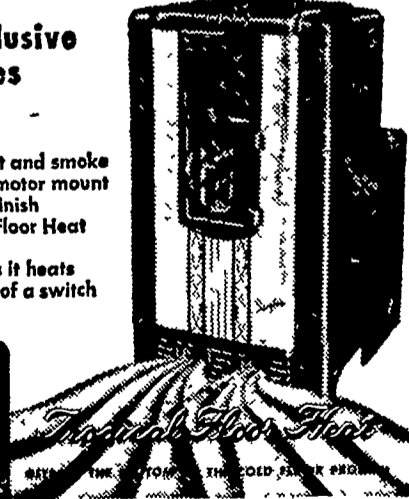
