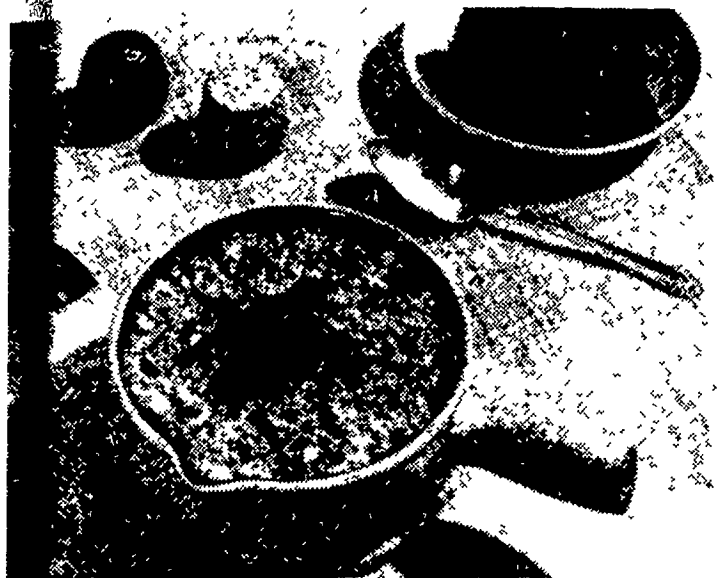

SEEDS EXPORTED

In September of this year, U S exports of grass and legume seeds totaled 1,969,000 pounds, compared with 1,750,000 lbs in Sept., 1957.

July to September exports of these seeds, however, were about 18 per cent below exports during the same period of 1957

Most of the September, 1958 exports went to Canada, Italy and Mexico
