### State's 1958 Chick Output Jumped 12% From '57 Totals

The State Crop Reporting Service has announced the preliminary estimate of production of all chicks in Penna for 1958 is 85,625,000, 12 per cent above the 76,466,000 produced in 1957.

Broiler-type hatch was up 11 per cent, and egg-type hatch rose 14 per cent from 1957. Production of chicks by commercial hatcheries in Penna during December totaled 5,486,000, four per cent above Dec, 1957.

Broiler-type production, comprising 84 per cent of the total, was up four per cent, while egg-type production was up two per cent from one year ago.

Larger January hatches than a year ago in N Y., N J and Pa, are in prospect. Broiler-type eggs in incubators on Jan. 1 in these states were up two percent, and egg type, 15 per cent above Jan 1, 1958.

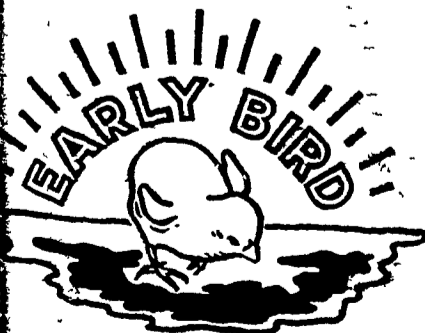
