heifers early, feed grain with high-quality roughage for at least 12 months, possibly 15 - 18 months. Don't be too quick to sell a first calf heifer, without giving her a second chance, especially when she is from a late-maturing "cow family." Plan replacements from your top cows with outstanding sires.

Also during the program, county dairymen heard extension specialists caution against use of excessive lengths of plastic hose in milking equipment. Ivan G. Parkin of Penn State noted that hose lengths in excess of 10 feet are illegal for use in New York state. He defined the new "dumping station" method as a stepping stone to pipeline milking.

Both systems, he pointed out, are intended to aid in maintaining sanitation if properly used—namely, save enormous amounts of labor in milk handling.

Dr. Samuel Guss, PSU livestock specialist, warned of a possibility of the cure being worse than the disease in the case of excessive use of antibiotics in mastitis treatment. He cautioned the herdsmen to temper treatment of udder troubles with reason, urging prevention as the best cure.

HARDWOODS FOLLOW PINES

Penn State's School of Forestry has found that in an unused field growing back into timber, the first crop of trees will be predominately pine. Hardwoods follow with the help of squirrels, birds, and wind distributing seeds.

MORE CORN

According to Penn State extension agronomists, if you want high corn yields, you have to get a high plant population and you must feed the plants well.

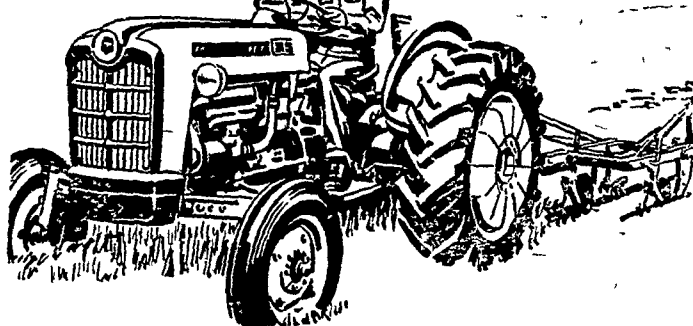

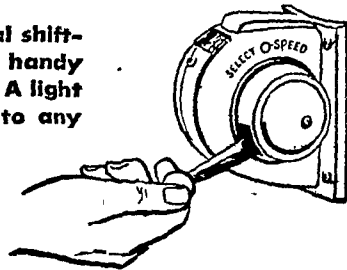
