**\$375 Cow Tops BF Record**

A registered Holstein pur-  
 chased for only \$375 in a  
 farm auction four years ago  
 has shattered her breed's

all-time national butterfat  
 record with an official 365  
 day production of 1,529 lbs.  
 in 33,718 lbs. of milk.

She is Jasmine Design  
 Mercedes - a nine year old  
 cow owned by Jack R. Budd,  
 Belleville, Michigan.

The Holstein-riesian Asso-  
 ciation of America has an-  
 nounced that her recently-  
 completed record sets a new  
 high in butterfat—regard-  
 less of age or milking fre-  
 quency—for registered Hol-  
 steins on official test

"Jasmine", as the new  
 champion is known around  
 the Budd place, started her  
 national record at the age  
 of 8 years 11 months. She  
 was milked three times daily  
 throughout her testing per-  
 iod.

She averaged more than  
 92 lbs. of milk and four lbs.  
 of butterfat a day for an en-  
 tire year, hitting a peak of  
 136 lbs. of milk a day in  
 her third month on test and  
 was still producing nearly  
 60 lbs. when a final check  
 test was made three  
 days before the close of her  
 365 day lactation.

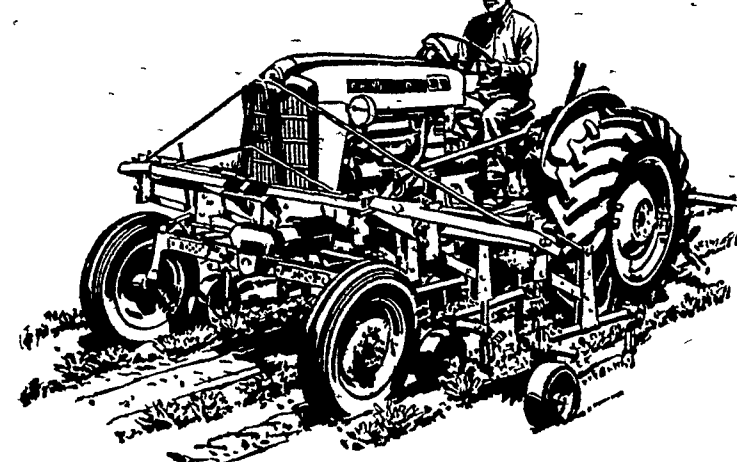
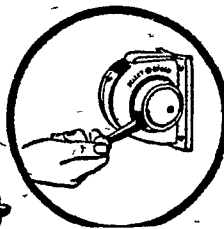
