**'Bigness' Problem Faces Egg
Co-ops, NEPPCO Parley Finds**

WASHINGTON, D. C. — The same poultry industry trends that are forcing production into the hands of fewer, but larger producers are at work in poultry and egg marketing organizations, it was agreed here this week by representatives of farm cooperatives from the 14 northeastern states.

More than 25 poultry and egg cooperative organizations were represented in the two-day conference, held under the sponsorship of the Division of Cooperatives of the Northeastern Poultry Producers Council (NEPPCO) at the Willard Hotel. Assisting in the annual winter business management workshop was the Farmer Cooperative Service of the U. S. Dept. of Agriculture.

The trend toward "bigness" in the poultry industry is one that can be expected to be intensified in the years ahead, the cooperative delegates agreed. Most look for increased cooperation between groups, ultimately

aimed at streamlined marketing and the possible consolidation of present plants of cooperatives.

Under scrutiny by the group was the proposed merger of some eight New England egg and poultry marketing cooperatives under the banner of the Eastern States Farmers Exchange, West Springfield Mass. Also studied was the federated activity among or your local repre

hogs more uniform for weight and grade including 1-2 grade scaling 190-215 lb. at 18-18 75 a few lots the same weight mostly No 1 at 19. 230-250 lb butchers made 16 50-17. 300-600 lb: sows brought 12-15.

Wooled slaughter lambs sold at steady rates. Receipts will total about the same as last week's 355 head count. Included in receipts were about 100 head of spring slaughter lambs Good and choice wooled slaughter lambs made 21 50-23, utility and low-grade brought 19 50-21.50. Good and choice spring slaughter lambs commanded 29-30.

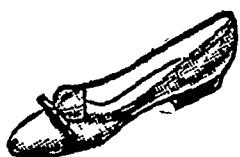

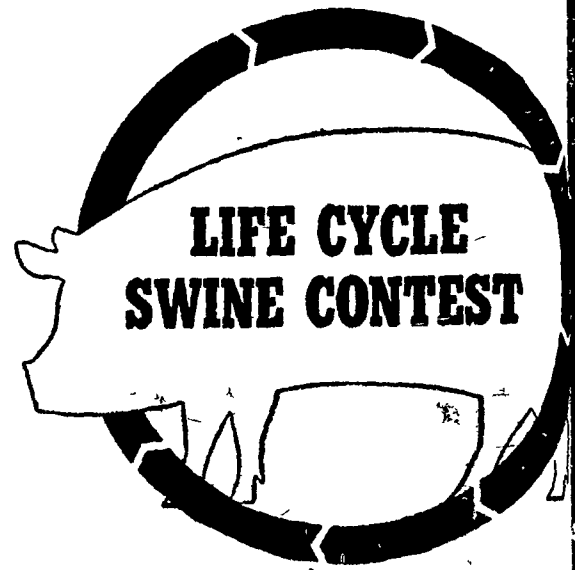
