

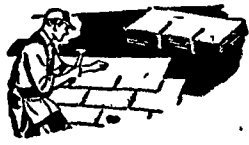
Nissley Herd Tops Red Rose DHIA Tests During February

Red Rose Dairy Herd Improvement Assn. has announced that the herd of 1379 lbs of milk and 55 lbs Mervin Nissley, Bainbridge had the highest butterfat average for the month of February for herds in the association. official testing program.

Nissley's herd averaged 1379 lbs of milk and 55 lbs of butterfat per cow, according to Red Rose officials. The herds of Ray P Bollinger, Stevens RD 1, and Allen K Risser, Bareville RD 1, tied for second place, with 1290 lbs. of milk and 51 lbs. of butterfat and 1288 lbs. of milk and 51 lbs. of butterfat respectively.

The highest 305-day lactation was completed by a registered Holstein owned by Mary B. Stoltzfus, Morgantown. The cow produced 19,603 lbs of milk and 942 lbs. of butterfat with a 4.8 test.

Second high lactation was completed by a registered Holstein owned by Gene Witmer, Churchtown, with 23,677 lbs. of milk and 554 lbs. of butterfat with a 3.6 test in 305 days.

Mid-March Price Index Off 2%

Prices received by Penna. farmers at mid-March for all farm products were down two per cent from the previous month. The index for all farm products at 229 per cent of the 1910-14 level, was down five points from the month before and eight per cent or 19 points below the same period of last year.

In the report from the state Crop Service, the principal cause of the decrease was as lower prices received for milk, eggs, calves and lambs and broilers. The group index dropped one percentage point from the month before. The principal cause of the decline was lower prices received for potatoes and all hay items. Items in the crop group that showed an increase were wheat, oats, barley, rye and beans.

Lancaster County swine breeders were reminded of the approaching need to be selecting gilts for the Summer Bred Gilt Sale of the Lancaster County Swine Producer's Assn., by Kenneth A Skiles, sec-treas. of the group.

All gilts should be bred after April 10 to a registered boar, Skiles stated.

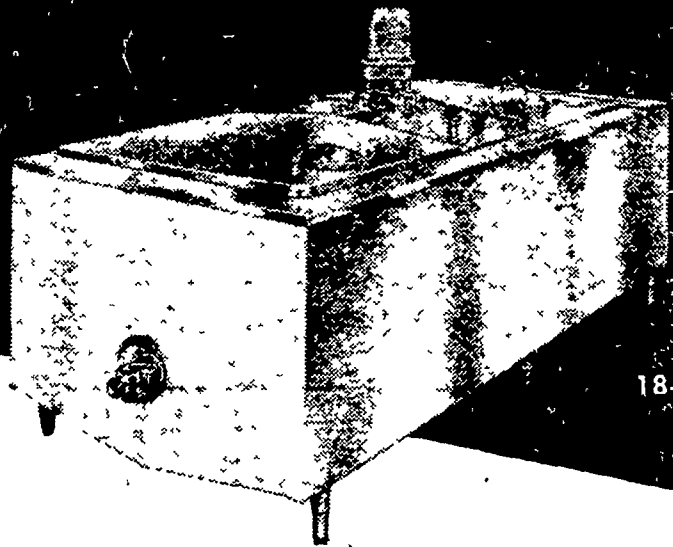
