At a recent meeting of the Willing Workers and Sunshine classes of the Mt. Zion E. U. B. Church near Cambridge, plans were completed for the annual church Chicken Barbeque, to be held at 4 p.m., April 25 on the church grounds.

L. S. Iverson, Phila. Milk market administrator has announced that April through June price for Class I milk, testing 3.7 per cent butterfat, will be \$5.29 per cwt. under Order 61. This is a 20 cent seasonal drop from the \$5.49 scale for the previous quarter.

Lancaster County Soil Conservation District enrolled 17 farmers from the Denver area Monday night as the result of an "Upper Cocalico Watershed Meeting." Eleven of the 17 farmers, signing up operate within the vital water-

shed area, while the entire enrollment blankets 1,305 acres in that area.

Another conservation meeting in the Mt. Joy area last week resulted in 12 new co-operators for the district, with the combined enrollment of the two meetings totaling almost one-third of 1958's increase for the district.

C. J. Blanford, New York-New Jersey milk market administrator, has announced that farmers in the milk shed

will receive a uniform farm price of \$4.54 per cwt. for Class I. 3.5 milk delivered in February.

Imports of meat and meat products by the U. S. during 1958 are now reported at 825,949,000 lbs., compared to 348,237,000 lbs. in 1957. Imports of all classes of meat rose sharply, with boneless beef and veal, mutton, and goat meat accounting for most of the increase.
