

Dead Crops May Draw Winter-Kill Payments

Gamber, district supervisor of the Federal Crop Insurance Program, reminded farmers with FCIC for their winter crop that they should have the crop inspected for winter kill for the winter.

He points out that if FCIC crop insurance find it to their advantage to file damage due to winter-kill, flood damage or loss of crop after a variety of acts are all covered under "all-hazard" policy

made available to Lancaster County farmers.

If stands are diminished to the point where continuation with the winter grain crop will be unprofitable, the farmer should notify his FCIC agent immediately.

In the event the farmer has sown grass seed in these fields and wishes to retain the grass stand, the acreage may be released for silage production Gamber added.

In all cases, where the farmer wishes to apply for the FCIC coverage, he must do so before planting the crop. Corn may be submitted until April 30 and type 41 tobacco until May 31.

Beginning with this year

an additional five per cent discount is available for earlier payment of premiums and participating no-loss discounts will begin after three years instead of after seven years.

Also available this year is co-insurance where the farmer only insures a portion of his crop investment, rather

than the full amount.

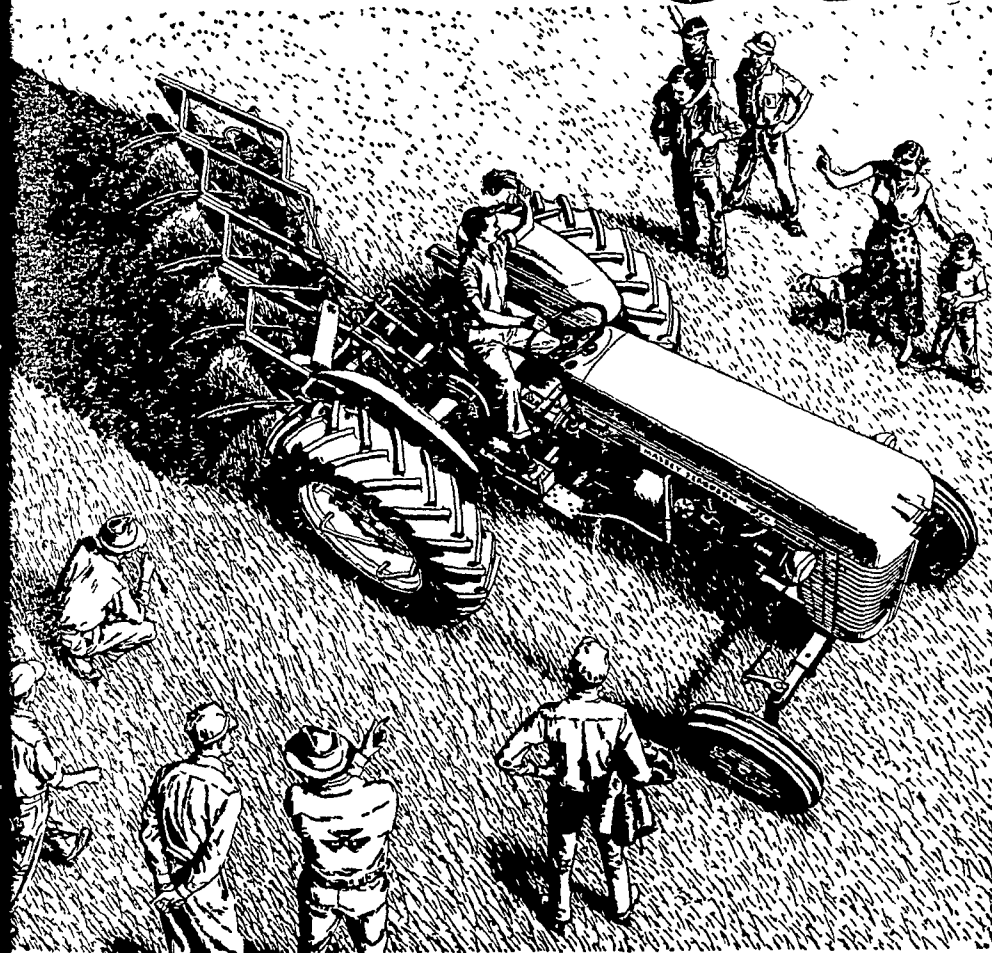

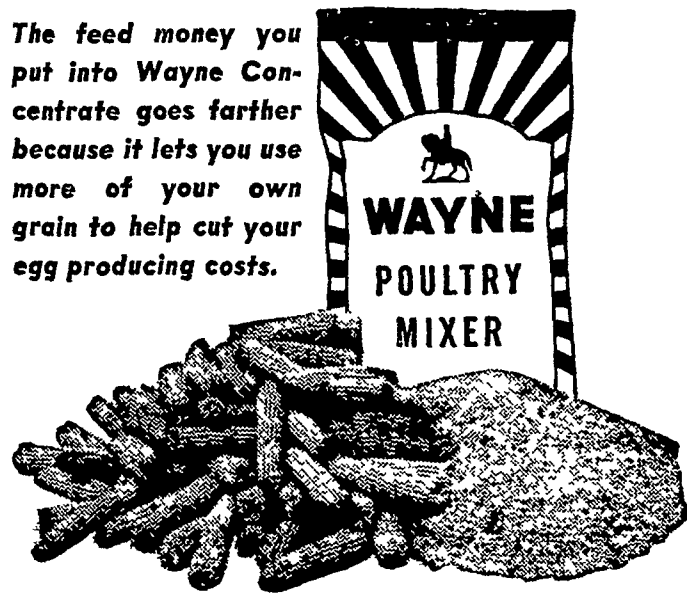
