Keep Chicks Comfortable

Keep chicks comfortable and you'll keep em' growing. Comfort, is mainly a matter of temperature under the hover and in the house. It is also affected by ventilation, floor space, condition of the litter, and feeding facilities.

As many chicks are ruined or weakened to become a prey to disease by too much heat as by too little. Excellent feathering, observed in chicks brooded under electric hovers, shows they can do with less heat in the brooder room so long as ample heat is provided at the hover.

Brittle, broken feathers may be due to too much heat which, in turn, may be due to poor ventilation.

Ample ventilation allows for more cool areas in the brooder room, and thus indirectly helps in the hardening off process.

During changeable weather it is a better means of controlling house temperature than in making frequent adjustments to the stove.

Watch the action of chicks. They will soon indicate whether or not they are comfortable. Chicks driven to the walls of the room are usually too hot.

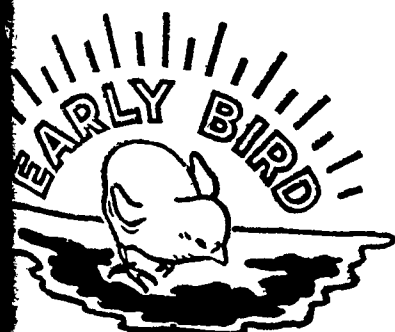
