### Household Hints

If your white dacron curtains seem gray after two or three washings you'll need to be sure to do a thorough wash and rinse job in hot water.

If the curtains hang near forced air heat, they may have picked up an oil film that gives them the gray look.

You may want to pretreat the curtains by making a paste of detergent and warm water and using this in soiled areas.

If you wash the curtains with soap be sure to use water softener in both the wash water and the first warm rinse. Rinse thoroughly.

To remove grease spots from wall paper make a stiff paste of corn starch or fuller's earth with a dry cleaning fluid and coat the spot, then let dry.

Rub lightly to remove the soil. You may be able to pick up some grease by putting a white blotter over the spot and holding a warm iron against the blotter.

Potash increases yields and prolongs the life of legumes. Two tons of good hay will remove from 60 to 70 lbs. of potash from the soil.

Stir down and mix in pecans. Turn batter into well-greased 10-inch tube pan. Let rise until doubled (about one hour). Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) about 35 minutes.

Combine confectioners' sugar and rum extract. Add milk to make icing thin. When coffee cake is cool, drizzle with icing. Makes one 10-in. tube coffee cake.

#### Strawberry Coffee Cake

2 cups sifted flour  
2 teaspoons baking powder  
6 tablespoons sugar  
¾ teaspoon salt

¼ cup shortening  
egg, beaten  
¾ cup milk  
1½ cups strawberries, cleaned  
3 tablespoons butter  
¼ cup sugar  
3 tablespoons sifted flour  
Sift first four ingredients together. Cut in shortening with two knives or pastry blender. Combine egg and milk and add all at once to dry ingredients. Blend thoroughly.

Spread dough in greased cake pan and arrange strawberries on top. Combine remaining ingredients and mix together with fork until a crumbly consistency.

Sprinkle over strawberries. Bake in hot oven (400 degrees) about 25 to 30 minutes. Makes one 10x6-inch coffee cake.

#### Strawberry Fluff Pie

1 pint strawberries  
¾ cup sugar  
½ teaspoon salt  
1 tablespoon lemon juice  
1 tablespoon unflavored gelatin  
½ cup cold water  
1 cup evaporated-milk, chilled  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1 Graham Cracker Piecrust  
Wash berries, hull and cut

into small pieces. Add sugar salt and lemon juice. Chill one hour or more.

Soften gelatin in water 5 minutes, dissolve over boiling water and add to chilled strawberry mixture. Whip milk very stiff and fold in. Add vanilla, turn into crust and chill until firm.

Garnish with berries. Serves six.
