Spread icing on sides of cake, saving out a small amount. Cover with cocoanut. Spread the remaining filling on top of cake. Using a decorator tube, pipe remaining icing around the top edge of the cake.

**Strawberry - Rhubarb Filling**

1 1-pound frozen rhubarb  
1 12-ounce package frozen strawberries  
2 teaspoons lemon juice  
Red food coloring

Thaw rhubarb and strawberries and combine in a salt, vanilla and milk. Beat

saucepan Cook over medium heat, stirring occasionally until reduced to a very thick sauce.

Add lemon juice and red food coloring. Cool thoroughly. Sufficient for filling a 3-layer, 8-inch cake

**Light Butter Icing**

1/2 cup butter  
1 1-pound box confectioners' sugar, sifted  
1/4 cup teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1 tablespoon milk  
1 egg

1/2 cup shredded cocoanut

Cream together butter, 1/2 of the confectioners' sugar, vanilla and milk. Beat

in eggs. Add remaining confectioners' sugar and beat until smooth.

If necessary, add additional milk to make of spreading consistency. Sufficient for filling and frosting a 2-layer, 8-inch cake

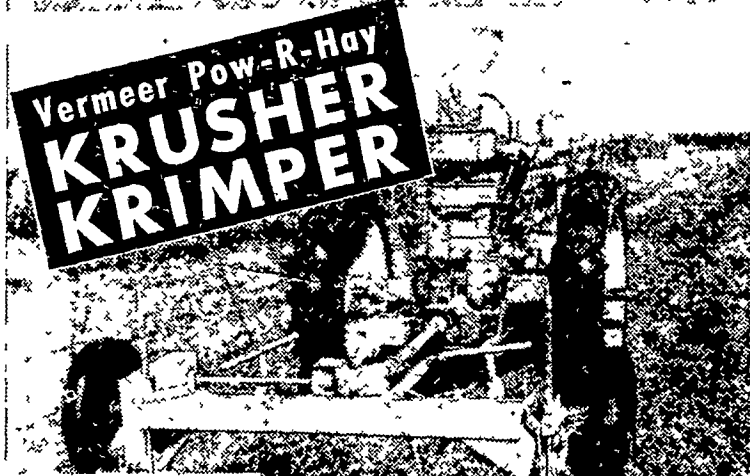
