

To be eligible for support, 1959-crop oats must grade No. 3 or better or No. 4 on the factor of test weight under the revised grain standards effective on June 1 of this year.

Premiums are one cent per bushel for Grade No. 2 or better, one cent for heavy test weight, and two cents for extra heavy test weight. Discounts are one cent per bushel for Grade No. 4 on the basis of test weight only and three cents for garlicky.


