

## Clean Storage Helps Protect Small Grains

The first step in successful storage of small grains is to completely clean all bins. This will involve cleaning behind partitions, between walls, and in cracks.

Following a clean-up, any holes in bins should be covered and it is well to sweep up any grain that may have leaked out or spilled to the ground.

After bins are cleaned, all inside surfaces may be sprayed with Methoxychlor insecticide

Methoxychlor has proven effective in control of cadellies, grain weevils, confused flour beetles, saw-toothed beetles, rice weevils, and other insects affecting stored grain

The spray should be applied about two weeks prior to storing grain. A twenty-five per cent methoxychlor solution may be mixed at the rate of two quarts of methoxychlor to five gallons of water

Using a knapsack, garden, or power sprayer, the material should be applied until the spray runs off.

Usually two gallons of the mixture will cover 1,000 sq feet of surface.

New grain should not be added on top of old grain,

and tests should be conducted to determine that the new grain is sufficiently dry for storage.

It also will pay to eliminate rats and mice. This may be accomplished by using one of the anticoagulant do-denticides.

## Requests For Wheat Quotas Being Taken

The ASC county office is accepting wheat allotment applications for certain farms.

A producer who intends to seed wheat for 1960 on a farm on which no wheat was seeded for harvest as grain in 1957 and for which a 1958 and 1959 allotment was not established, irrespective of whether or not wheat was seeded for harvest as grain in either 1958 or 1959, and who desires to be considered

for an allotment must make application for an allotment, according to Landis G. Becker, Chairman of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Committee. Application forms are available in the ASC Office for use in the request for an allotment. A producer must apply by July 1, 1959.
