# DelMarVa Drops Again

Delmarva closed Friday with a 16-17 cent market on 765,200 broilers.

Georgia closed with Friday sales of 1,337,000 head at 15 cents. Estimated slaughter for Fri. & Sat. is 1,736,000.

Delmarva's weekly volume was 3,603,200 head, with prices moving up from Monday's 16-16.9 range to 16.5-17.8 on Wed. and dropping again Friday.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio was 3.3, with broilers averaging 16.56 and feed at \$99.80 for the week ending July 24. The previous week's ratio was 3.4, a year ago, 3.6.

Georgia totaled 6,153,000 head of broilers from Friday through Thursday, with the market at 15 cents over the weekend, moving up to 15-15.9, sagging to 15-15½ on Wed. and regaining strength to 15-16 Thursday.
