

## Tobacco Field Day Set

The Lancaster County Extension Service, in cooperation with the Southeastern Research Laboratory and the USDA, has announced an all-day tour of eight county farms on Tuesday, for the purpose of acquainting county farmers with tests on tobacco varieties, chemical weed control in tobacco and fertilization in tobacco.

The tour will give local farmers a first-time and first-hand chance to see five disease resistant tobacco varieties developed by the USDA under farm conditions.

The varieties have shown resistance to both mosaic and wildfire, and superior production results. Each new variety is being grown with the farmers' own tobaccos, as well as Swarr-Hibshman, for checks.

Each half-acre test plot of new tobacco is being handled in the former's normal way, with four cigar companies doing the processing.

The tour will begin at the Research Lab, north of Landisville, at 9:30.

Farms to be visited during the day, in order, are:

Morning: Willis Hackman, Etown 3, new varieties; Ray Hahn, Columbia 1, new varieties and chemical weed control, and L. E. Herchelroth, Silver Spring, tobacco fertilization.

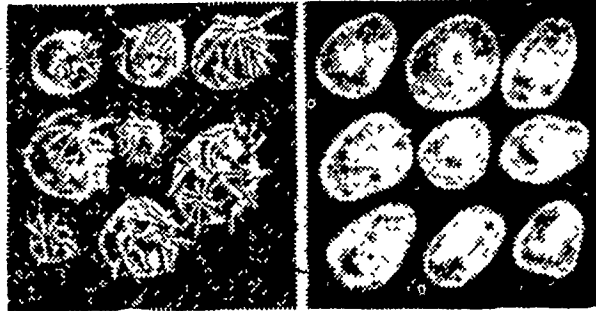
Afternoon: John Shenk II, Willow Street 1, fertilization; Aaron Weaver, Q-ville 2, new varieties and chemical weed control; Lester Weaver, New Holland 1, new varieties; Homer Martin, Lititz 4, fertilization, and Loyd Shreiner, Lititz 2, fertilization.

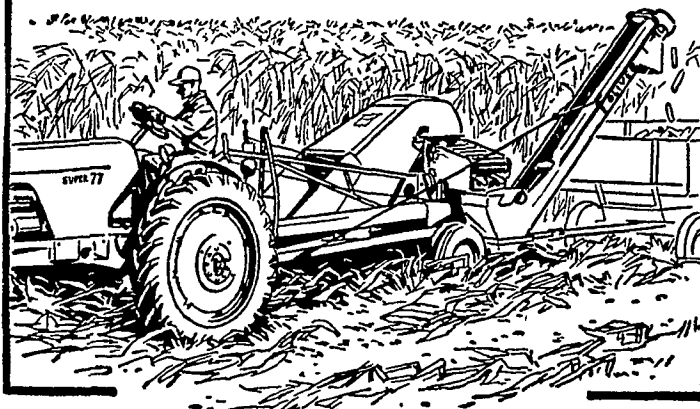

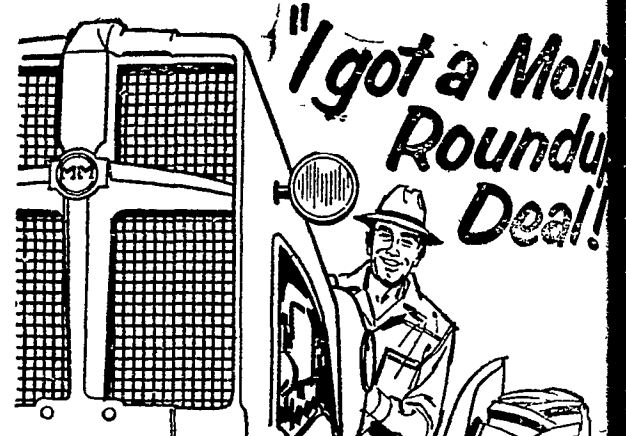
