PRINCIPAL FACTORS

Economical Milk Production

Good Roughage — This is the greatest single factor in economical milk production.

Roughage of proper quality meets 75% of the total requirements for maintenance and milk production.

Note: This emphasizes the need for Dairymen to concentrate their efforts on production of good roughage.

Feed the individual cow to meet her requirements — Do not feed the herd as a unit.

For instance: A cow producing 35 lbs. of milk needs less 16% dairy feed than a 50 lb. producer.

If the herd is fed uniformly rather than on an individual basis the low producing animal will get too much feed and waste it, or the high producers will not eat enough to properly sustain production.
