try under the Poultry Products Inspection Act were announced recently by the U. S. Dept. of Agriculture,

This Act requires Federal inspection of slughtered poultry and poultry products shipped across State lines.

The amendments incorporate defnitions of poultry class names which are required on labels of inspec ed poultry. Alternative labeling terminology also is specified.

The amendments exclude from the definition of poultry products subject to the inspection act certain products which contain some poultry meat, provided that this meat is from inspected poultry.

Examples of such products are bouillon cubes, sauces, flavorings, and soup bases and soups containing less than two per cent poulty meat.

Cop'es of the amendments will be available from the Poultry Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, U S. Department of Agriculture, Washington 25, D C, within a few days after publication in the Federal Register, schduled for Aug. 22.
