or salt mixed with feed to
supply all their salt needs.

Trace-mineralized salt will
provide many of the minerals
needed by the animal only in
small quantities.

However, Way says it does

not provide the two miner-
als, calcium, and phosphor-
us, which are required in
larger amounts.

Mineral mixtures should
provide both calcium and
phosphorus.

A simple mixture, such as
two parts steamed bone meal
and one part salt, or two
parts dicalcium phosphate,
and one part salt, will pro-
vide these important miner-
als in about the correct pro-
portions.

Even though salt is includ-
ed in this mineral mixture,
it is best to feed salt separ-
ately.

Any amateur carpenter
can build a strong wooden
box with a partition through
the middle, Way adds. Put
salt on one side of the par-
tition, and a mineral mixture
on the other, and see that
each shed or lot has a min-
eral box available.

Flourescent lamps are of-
ten a good choice for home
lighting, says Miss Sanna
Black, Penn State extension
home management specialist.
They give between two and
three times more light for
the same wattage as filament
bulbs. Flourescent lamps also
produce less heat and are
lower in brightness than fila-
ment bulbs.

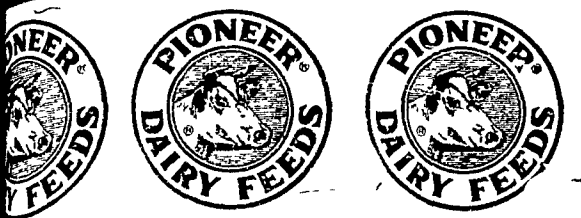

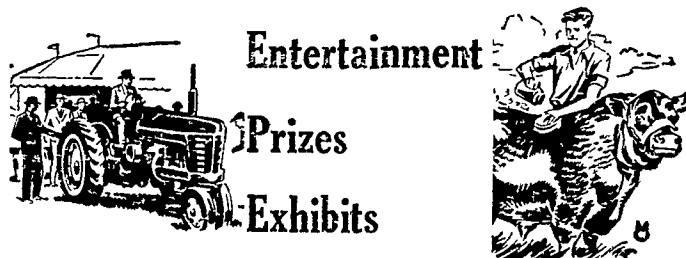
