BROILERS GROW FASTER ON PELLETS

In a test with 1,800 broiler type chicks, University of Tennessee researchers learned that pelleting improved the growth rate and feed efficiency of broilers. Chicks in the experiment fed a pelleted, high protein, high-energy diet were significant'y larger at nine weeks of age. In the pelleted form, chicks needed as little as 2.4 pounds of feed to produce a pound of live broiler. It took 2.6 pounds of the same feed in mash form. In a test using a lowprotein, low-energy ration, the chicks on pel'ets needed 27 pounds of feed for a pound of gain compared to


