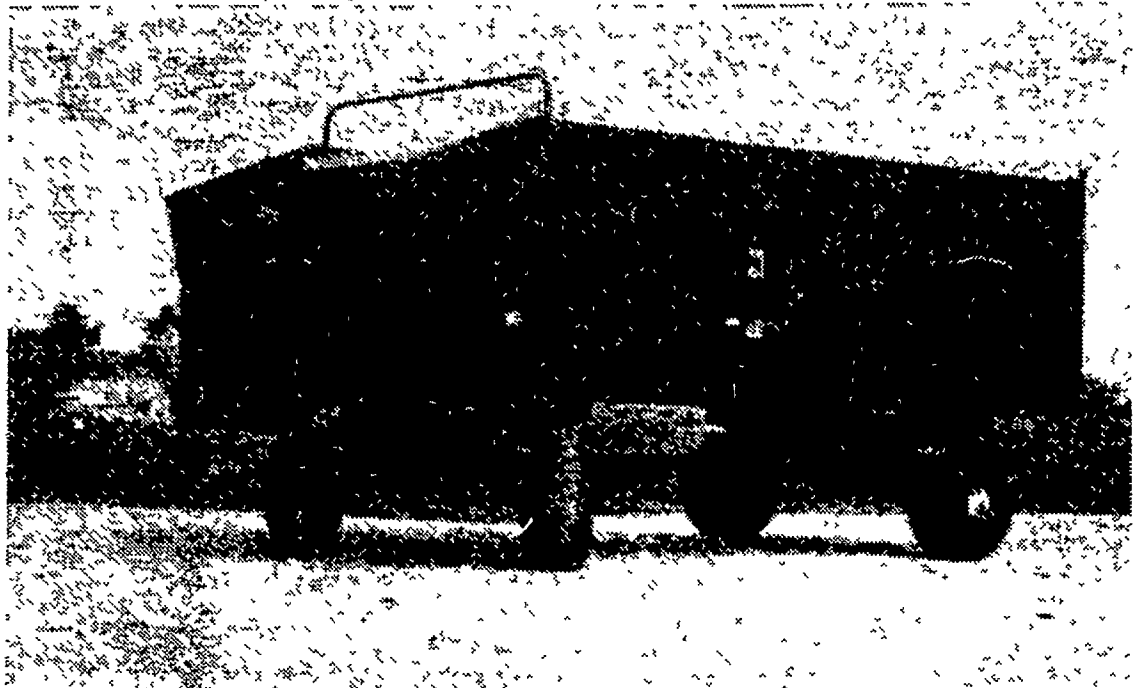


## Forage Wagon Wears Airplane Tires

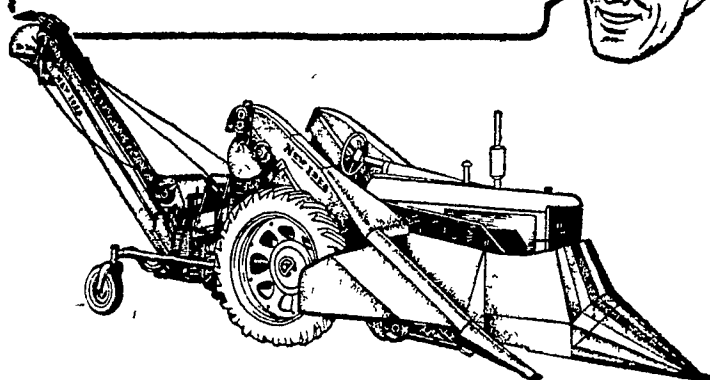

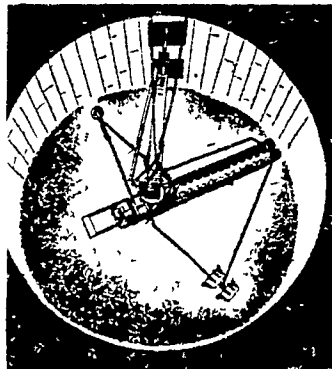

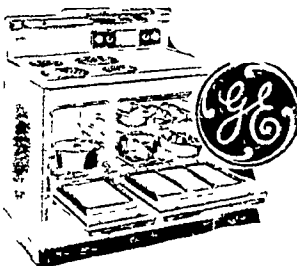
