Dr Esterbrooks, a member of the Kennett Square Junior Chamber of Commerce, served as its secretary last year and is presently serving as its President.

He and his wife, the former Miss Norina Plimpton of Sturbridge, Massachusetts have three children, all girls: Cheryl Faye, 11; Susan Raye 9½, and Sandra Kaye, 4. The two older girls are presently enrolled at Kennett Consolidated School but are looking forward to their new home and friends in Oxford soon.
