00-26 50. Good and Choice 550-800 lb stock steers made 26 50-30.50 while medium and Good made 25.50-27.50. Good grade stock calves from 29 00-33 00.

CALVES: In the calf division this week vealers were steady to 1 higher on about 700 head or slightly more than last week's count. Trading was active Good and Choice vealers commanded 28.00-35.00, and Choice and Prime made 35 00-40 00, with a few to 41.00, Standard and low Good made 22 00-28.00, while Utility sold down to 18.00.

HOGS: Barrows and gilts were 25-50 higher compared with last week's close Sows held steady. Trading was active on about 1325 head or 200 head less than last week. U. S. 1-3 grade 190-230 lb barrows and gilts made 14 25 to 15.00 but mostly 14 50-14 75, No 3 and 235-250 pound hogs sold at 14.00. Hogs more uniform for weight and grade including 1-2 grade 190-230 lb butchers brought 15 00-16.00, a few U. S. 1 made 16 50. 300-600 lb sows crossed the scales at 8 00-12 00.

SHEEP: The quality of slaughter lambs was improved this week. Trading was active on 600 head or about the same as last week Slaughter lambs sold steady to 50 higher. Good and Choice 65-95 lb lambs brought 20 00-21.75, several lots Choice 75-95 lb. made 22.00-23 00, while utility sold down to 16.00.
