

Farm Show Deadline Near Warns Exposition Chairman

Livestock breeders are reminded that November 16 is the deadline for entries in the 44th Annual Farm Show to be held January 11, thru 15.

John E. McCool, Farm Show director, today said that premium lists have been mailed to county agents and vocational agriculture supervisors throughout the state. General and special entry blanks are included in the premium list.

Entries for horses, sheep, swine, beef cattle, dairy cattle and the folk dance contest close November 16. Other early closing dates are November 9 for school exhibits, November 11 for the state school demonstration contest and Nov 14 for breed meets in the poultry department.

McCool also outlines some changes made in the dairy cattle and livestock departments for the coming Farm Show. Exhibitors of dairy cattle and livestock are being asked to use entry cards this year. Cards have been mailed to all former exhibitors. A separate card must be used for each individual class and group entry.

Dairy and beef cattle exhibitors have been sent two applications for health charts for each animal to be exhibited. McCool says that use of the health chart application and the entry card will speed resigstration of entries in the show.

New exhibitors may receive cards and health chart applications from county agents, vocational agriculture supervisors or by writing to McCool at the Farm Show Building, Harrisburg.

Early entries are being urged by McCool. He points out that last year 190 dairy cows were turned away because of lack of space. He said that space will be reserved for exhibitors in the order in which applications are received based upon date and time of postmark within breed space quotas.

For the dairy department, these are the quotas: Ayrshire, 55; Brown-Swiss, 45; Guernsey, 95; Holstein, 140;

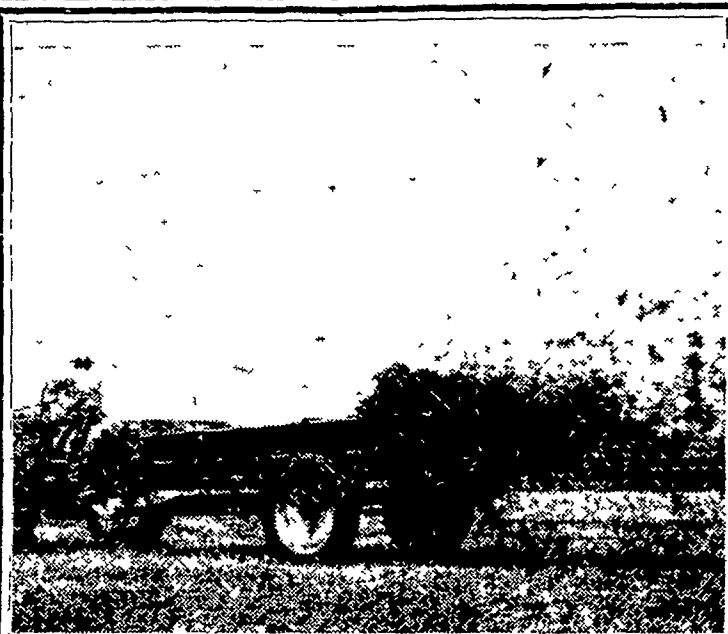

carry most of the load of operating the newly installed push button mill and bulk handling equipment.

With much of the volume in poultry feeds the mill has storage facilities for 850 tons of bulk feed and many more tons of feed in bags. Recently most of the feed is packaged in paper bags to help the farmer with rat control and waste of feed as well as economy of packaging.

TRY SAMPLE FIRST

Except for potatoes marked as bakers, labels seldom indicate cooking quality.
