**Speaker Named For Pa. Holstein Annual Meeting**

Enos J. Perry, New Brunswick, N J, one of Pennsylvania's first county agricultural agents and a pioneer in dairy artificial breeding, today was named a speaker for the Pennsylvania Holstein Association annual convention Nov. 18-20 at the Pennsylvania State University.  
Professor Perry is now retired as head of dairy extension at Rutgers University. In the late 1930's he made a special study of dairy artificial breeding in Denmark and on his return introduced this program in the United States. Now one-third of all U. S. dairy cows, and one-half of those in Pennsylvania, are included in this program.  
Just returned from his last trip to Europe, he will speak on "Livestock Abroad" A Delta, York county, native, he was educated at Penn

State, and from 1916 to 1930 served as the University's first county agent in York county
