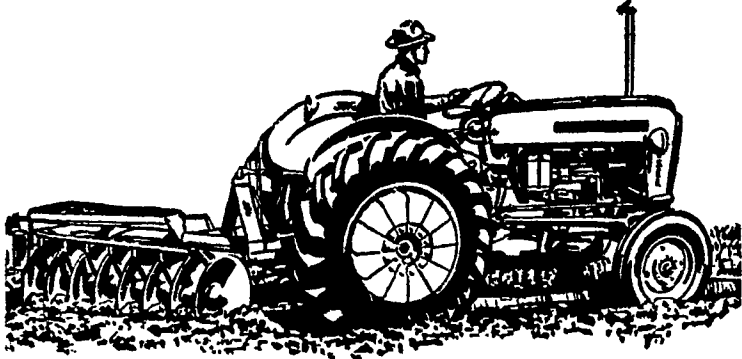

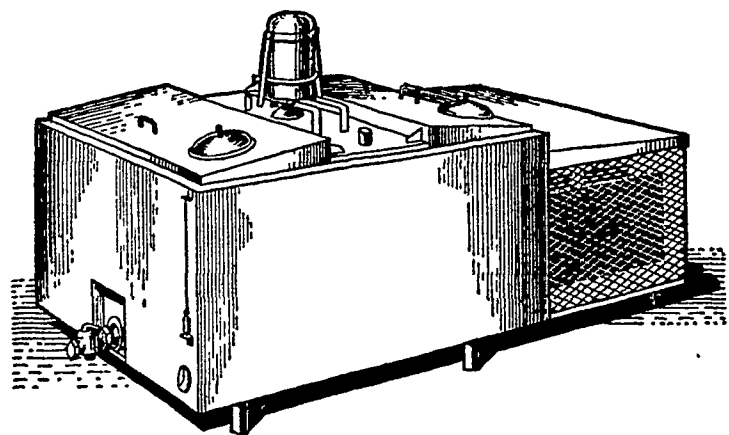

Cooperative Potato Growers Attend National Convention

President Leland W. Nixon of State College leads a delegation of Pennsylvania Co-operative Potato Growers Association members to the National Potato Council's annual meeting in Chicago November 17-19 with an "up-and-down" report in the 1959-60 potato season in the Keystone State.

The season started with extra early and favorable planting and growing conditions in the scattered potato-growing areas of the state, however, rainfall deficiencies were encountered in all areas from late June through mid-August. Hardest hit were parts of the three top potato counties—Lehigh, Lancaster and Erie.

Temperatures during the summer months averaged the highest known for many years. Excessively hot and humid weather extended from early July into September when temperatures were 3 to 6 degrees above normal except during the week of the 14th when record lows were set in many parts of the state and the first frosts came to northern counties.

By mid-September soil moisture reserves were short in all areas except in the southeastern quarter of the state. Most moisture during the latter part of the growing season came from scattered local showers and thunderstorms and humidity was high during much of the time. Few occurrences of late blight were reported.

Lancaster had only about 16.5 inches, more than 7 inches below normal. The Le

high area endured near-drought conditions most of the summer and then some sections got too much rain toward the latter part of the season. Erie was nearly four inches under normal and the Potter county area was very dry until the end of the season.

Actual plantings were estimated at 46,000 acres. Latest production estimates (Oct. 1) are for a total crop of 7,781,000 hundredweight, down slightly from the Sept 1 forecast.

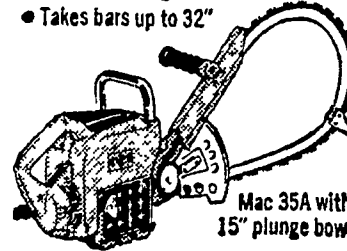
