

2 Broiler Lots Sold

Week's low prices at Lancaster Poultry Center edged most of the prices this week. Prices improve much and two lots of broilers sold. Growers withheld lots of broilers and four capettes. One lot of White Vantress broilers received a bid. Growers were reluctant to light birds before the giving holiday. Prices continued strong with the exception of capettes. Turkeys were active. 20 lots of 32,875 were offered and 12 lots of 10,825 birds were sold. Two lots of 4,425 broilers brought 16 1-16 3. Three 1900 turkeys sold for 3 lots of Leghorn brought 9.1-9.5. One lot of capettes sold for 21. Cockerel capettes were at prices of 26-29 1. Note: Next Week's will be held on Friday, November 27 due to Thanksgiving being November 22. Holiday Pushes Offerings Down

Delmarva opened slowly this week with offerings fully ample for the dull demand, and prices ranging from 14 to 15 90

Demand continued weak through Thursday as most of the buying interest centered on turkeys. Prices and reported purchases to 10 30 on Friday were 13 50 to 15 50 on 401,900 head. Estimated slaughter for the week end is 500,000 head.

The Delmarva broiler feed ratio for the week ending Nov 13 was unchanged from last week at 3 3. Feed cost \$92 82 per ton and broilers averaged 15 19. This compares with a 3 3 ratio six months ago when broilers brought 16 60 and feed was

Fluid Milk Production Is Mostly Steady

Production levels of fluid milk were reported unchanged to slightly lower than last week but supplies were ample to meet a good bottling demand. A light surplus over class one needs was diverted to separators for fluid cream needs or readily utilized for manufacturing purposes.

In New York prices advanced as much as 10 cents with 40 quart units of bottling quality milk reported at \$5 90 to \$6 00.
