

# Holiday Postpones Sale

# Offering Down Due to Holiday

Delmarva sales reported since Wednesday and up until 10:30 Friday were 90,100 head. In the absence of any sale on Thursday at the poultry growers exchange, 53% of the sales were at undetermined prices, and 47% were inter company transfers.

Estimated slaughter for the week end is 458,000 head.

Tuesday's market closed with 333,600 head going at prices of 15 to 16.40.

The Delmarva broiler feed ratio for the week ending Nov. 20 was 3.2 - down one point from last week. Broilers averaged 14.69 and mash cost \$93.16. Ratio this week last year was 3.6 with feed costing \$91.84 and broilers bringing 16.44.

Georgia reported sales to 10:30 Friday morning at 1,424,000 head selling 13.5 to 16.00. Estimated slaughter in Georgia for the week end is 1,608,000.

Twenty-five million Americans hunt and fish, reports Robert Wingard, Penn State extension wildlife management specialist. They spend nearly \$3,000,000,000 for 500,000,000 days of sport. In Pennsylvania alone sportsmen spend at least \$140,000,000 each year.

Underground drainage from septic tanks, cesspools, silos, and barnyards can ruin an otherwise good water supply, reminds Henry Woodling, Penn State extension agricultural engineer. He urges the use of adequate safeguards.
