In the lot came from Centre county, Pennsylvania and weighed 400 and 410 pounds. Local club leaders had a few words of encouragement for the young cattle feeders about to embark on a program designed to put about two pounds of gain per day in the right places on the carcasses of their calves.

In helping the club members get off to a good start, Max Smith, County Agent,

told the youths that the calves had been through a period of stress during weaning and trucking in the past few days and should be treated kindly but firmly. He warned that now while the calves are small is the time to start training them because they can be handled easier. He also cautioned club members to never let the calf learn that it can run away from its owner or it will develop bad habits and be harder to train later on. Before the drawing for

the calves, Donald Hosler, Manheim R3 and Fred Bernhardt, Orchard Road, Mt Joy presented the demonstration they will enter in national competition at Club Congress in Chicago next week.

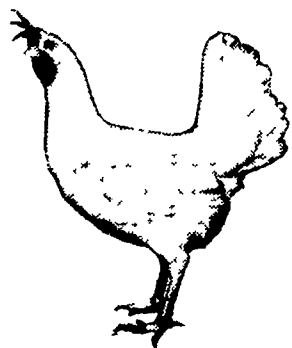

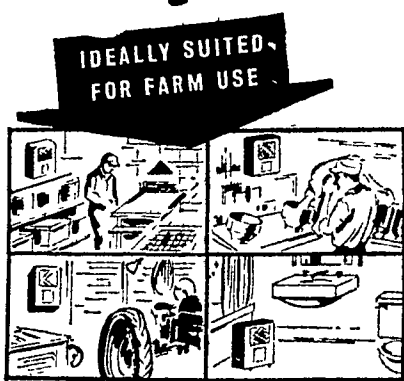

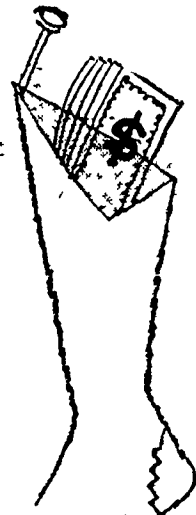
