

Harry Everett Is District Secretary Of Agriculture

Pennsylvania Secretary of Agriculture William L. Henning on Thursday, Nov. 19 announced that Harry A. Everett, Carroll Park, Bloomsburg, has been appointed manager of the Lansdale District Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture.

Everett has been area supervisor of agricultural education in Columbia and Montour Counties since November 1938. Prior to that time, he was vocational agricultural instructor at Turbotville High School.

In his new post, Everett will supervise field service activities of the State Department of Agriculture in the nine county area served by the Lansdale District Office. These counties include: Philadelphia, Delaware, Chester, Bucks, Berks, Montgomery, Lehigh, Northumberland and Schuylkill.

Everett was graduated from The Pennsylvania State University in 1925 with a B.

S. degree in agricultural education. He also holds a Master of Science degree from Bucknell University.

He is a past president of the Bloomsburg Kiwanis Club, a life member of the Pennsylvania Education Association, and a member of the National Education Association, The American Vocational Association, and the Pennsylvania County Superintendents Association.

Lamb Grading Out For Year

Secretary of Agriculture Ezra Taft Benson announced recently that the Federal grading service for lamb and mutton will be suspended for one year, effective January 4, 1960.

This action follows strenuous efforts on the part of the Department to develop a set of official grade standards which would be objective and meaningful, and which would be generally acceptable to all segments of the lamb industry. This has not been possible.

Early this year a number of organizations requested that Federal lamb grading be terminated. On July 23, 1959 the Secretary announced that Federal lamb grading would be continued but that the Department would proceed promptly to revise existing lamb standards. At that time the Secretary stated, "If improved grade standards for lamb and mutton are not developed to more adequately meet the needs of the industry, the Department will give further consideration to suspension of Federal grading of lamb and mutton carcasses."

Little Angel Cookies

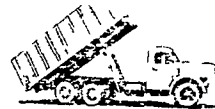

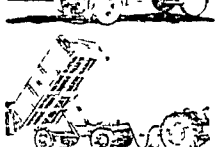
