Trading in Delmarva opened quietly this week with the offerings fully adequate for the limited demand.

By mid week a majority of the dressing plants were curtailing their operations sharply or dressing turkeys.

Estimated slaughtered for the week end was 387,000 head. Prices reported for the 24 hour period up to 10:30 Friday morning were 18-19.-70 for 374,000 head.

The broiler-feed ratio for the week ending December 11 was up to 4.3, six points over the previous week's 3.7. Mash was down only slightly at \$93.28 per ton, but the average price of live birds rose from 17.45 to 19.94 during the week. The ratio is 12 a-2. 




