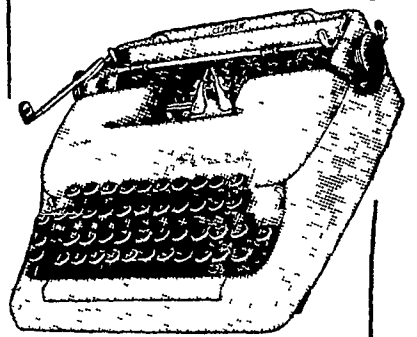

lost all its topsoil to erosion and half the land has lost at least 50 per cent of the top soil.

Talks illustrated with color slides, by Martin Muth, Soil Conservation Service work unit conservationist, and Howard Busch, Area conservationist, pointed out the need for conservation practices, and the results achieved where these practices have been carried out

Very little of the land in Lancaster County is class I land, Muth pointed out This means that the land will maintain itself with a minimum or no conservation practices "Too many people think of soil conservation in terms of contour strips" he said, "But it is many more things, and no two farms follow the same pattern.
